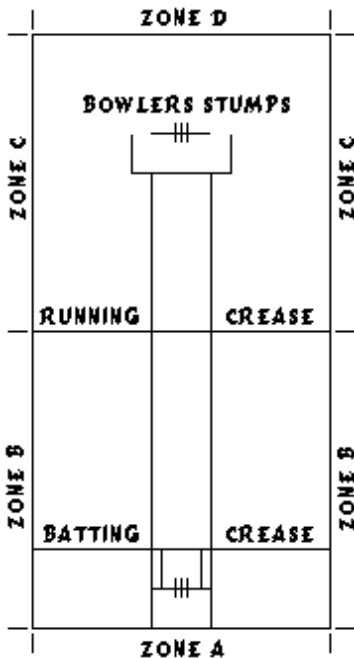


INDOOR CRICKET



Rules

Runs are scored by hitting the ball into the nets as well as running between the batting crease and the running crease. The net values are as follows.

- Zone A - 0 runs
- Zone B - 1 run
- Zone C - 2 runs
- Zone B or C then onto Zone D - 3 runs
- Zone D - 4 runs
- Zone D (on full) - 6 runs

On the other side, five runs are lost each time one of the following things happens to either batter.

- Bowled
- Caught
- Run Out
- Stumped
- Hit Wicket
- L.B.W.



The Event Convenor will act as referee and settle any disputes that may arise.
