Rules

The competition will be a singles event with each Area entering one competitor.

The first round will be on a league basis with matches consisting of the best of three games to nine points, or two clear points thereafter. Points will be awarded as follows:

- 3 points for 2 - 0
- 2 points for 2 - 1
- 1 point for 1 - 2

Equal points in the league to be decided on point's difference during the games, i.e. points scored minus points conceded. If point's difference is equal, the result of the match between the two players concerned is considered.

Further rounds will be on a knockout basis. In these rounds, the matches will also consist of best of three games to nine points, or two clear points thereafter. The semi-finals and final will be the best of five games to nine points, or two clear points thereafter. The semi-finals and final of the main competition will be umpired. The players will score all the earlier matches.

Outdoor footwear is not permitted in the playing area and non-marking sport shoes must be worn. The placings down to 16th to be determined on the basis of games won, and thereafter on the basis of points difference (points for minus points against). Results of the quarter and semi-finals will take priority over league results for final positions. The number of leagues and format of leagues will be dependant on the number of teams entering on the day of the competition and the organisers reserve the right to alter the rules of the event and the format on the day. However competitors will be informed of any changes to the above prior to the commencement of the competition.

The Event Convenor will act as referee and settle any disputes that may arise. Mitch Robinson, NSW 2008 Sports Convenor, will perform final arbitration
